## 10 Steps for gathering

- Care**  
Share highs and lows since last meeting, then prayer for each other
- Goals**  
How did you do on your Grow, Go & Gather goals?
- Worship**  
Through song, scripture, Lord's Supper, giving, etc
- Vision**  
Share updates and prayer over SOI/Oikos.  
Review the previous week's story and application/goals
- Command**  
Read the command's passage
- Story**  
Read the story twice (letting everyone read a portion), then piece the story back together from memory
- Observation**  
What do we observe about God in the story?  
What do we observe about people in the story?  
Is there a command or example to follow?
- Application**  
What is a tangible way we can apply what we learn from the story?  
Set goals to Grow, Go and Gather.
- Practice**  
Practice any tools to help achieve the goals.  
Invite others to lead different steps (care, goals, etc) for the next meeting.
- Prayer**

## 10 Stories Illustrating Jesus' Commands

<b>1st Gathering</b>	<p><b>Come to Jesus:</b> "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." Matthew 11:28</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: Luke 7:36-50</b></p>
<b>2nd Gathering</b>	<p><b>Repent &amp; Believe in Jesus:</b> "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!" Mark 1:15</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: Luke 19:1-10</b></p>
<b>3th Gathering</b>	<p><b>Follow Jesus:</b> "Follow me," he told him, and Matthew got up and followed him." Matthew 9:9b</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: Luke 18:18-30</b></p>
<b>4th Gathering</b>	<p><b>Be Baptized:</b> "baptizing them (new disciples) in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:19b</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to Read: Acts 8:26-39</b></p>
<b>5th Gathering</b>	<p><b>Make Disciples:</b> "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations" Matthew 28:19a</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: John 4:4-42</b></p>
<b>6th Gathering</b>	<p><b>Take the Lord's Supper:</b> "do this in remembrance of me." Luke 22:19b</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: Luke 22:7-20</b></p>
<b>7th Gathering</b>	<p><b>Be Church:</b> "And let us not neglect our meeting together" Hebrews 10:25a</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: Acts 2:36-47</b></p>
<b>8th Gathering</b>	<p><b>Pray:</b> "This, then, is how you should pray." Matthew 6:9a</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: Matthew 6:5-15</b></p>
<b>9th Gathering</b>	<p><b>Abide/Be Filled with the Spirit:</b> "be filled with the Spirit" Ephesians 5:18b</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: Luke 4:1-22</b></p>
<b>10th Gathering</b>	<p><b>Love Generously:</b> "Love your neighbor as yourself." Matthew 22:39</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Story to read: Luke 10:25-37</b></p>
